In the evening also the Portuguese colleagues arrived - so our team was complete.

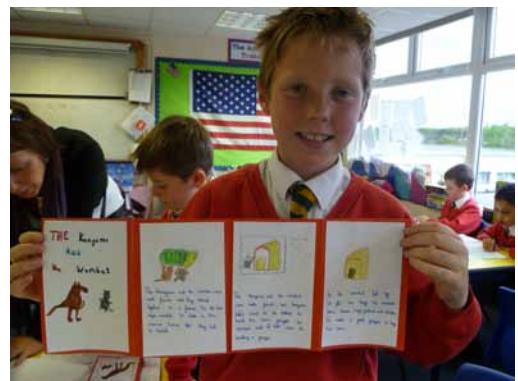


Monday, 23rd
